RANGE RULES

As a member of the Canastota Conservation Club, Inc., you have agreed to abide by the following rules for using the rifle and pistol ranges.

You must be a registered member of the Club, signed in and have your membership I.D. card visible, or you are a temporary member of the Club and signed in with your sponsor member present and signed in. The exception being a Club sanctioned event for youth.

Range hours of availability are from 9:30am to sunset, every day of the calendar, excepting those days and hours scheduled in advance listed on the website.

The firing line for the 100 yard through the 300-yard firing line and the 600-yard firing line have **red alarm safety light switches** located strategically in front of many shooting benches. Please be courteous to other shooters before activating the **red alarm safety light switch**, including the 600-yard firing line.

When the **red alarm safety lights** are activated, the following actions are mandated.

- A. All firearms shall be made safe.
 - a. Bolt action rifles will have the bolt back, breech open and a CCC "EMPTY CHAMBER" safety flag in the breech.
 - b. Semi-automatic rifles will have the bolt back, breech open and a CCC "EMPTY CHAMBER" safety flag in the breech.
- B. Shooters will step back from the firing line and not handle any firearm until the **red alarm safety lights** have been extinguished.
- C. The shooter activating the **red alarm safety lights** is the **ONLY** shooter that shall extinguish the **red alarm safety light switch** they activated.

No stake (stick in the ground) targets are allowed; paper targets and steel targets must be located within 10 feet of the existing berm.

No 50 calibre rifles are allowed on the range. No armor piercing rounds or incendiary rounds are allowed on the range. No automatic fire rifle or trigger devices that would simulate automatic fire are allowed on the range.

Targeting is only from the benches on the firing line. Rifles and shoulder fired firearms must be positioned on the bench on a front barrel rest (Bi-pod or commercial front barrel rest) and the rear stock in or on a rear stock rest.

Hearing protection is strongly advised on the firing line at all times. Eye protection is also strongly advised when discharging a firearm.
